

Kandersteg Kit List

TRAVELLING KIT

FULL Scout uniform - green shirt, blue trousers, shoes not trainers

KIT TO BE PACKED IN A DAY-SACK

(Oh yes it will fit!!!!)

Kandersteg T-shirt and necker Plain tasteful uniform shorts (dark blue), trainers Washing kit, soap, towel, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb Sunglasses, sun hat, sun tan cream (protection factor 6+), Swimming trunks Cagoule, sweater, socks etc - spare clothes for 2 days/nights Sandwich box with food for Sunday tea and supper, mug, dish, spoon Sheet sleeping bag (for ferry, YHAs and expeditions), pyjamas camera (optional)

(we've done it before!!)

KIT TO BE PACKED IN A STUFF-SACK

Sleeping bag (foam mats will be stacked separately)

KIT TO BE PACKED IN MAIN RUCKSACK

Waterproofs (cagoule & overtrousers), gloves, woolly hat, sweaters Boots (essential for hikes), spare laces, dubbin Unbreakable plate, knife, fork, tea towel, flask or unbreakable bottle – identifiable Small first aid kit, insect repellent, lip salve Torch, whistle, plastic survival (bivvy) bag Campfire blanket Spare long trousers (denim jeans <u>never</u> allowed on Scout camp!) Shorts, T-shirts, socks, undies, handkerchiefs (One on, one off and one in the wash!) Polythene bags for wet/dirty kit, wire coat hanger, pen & pencil

NOTES

Each person is allowed a rucksack, daysack, foam mat and stuff sack only! NO personal stereos! (or even monos), computer games etc. No big coats (waterproofs and sweaters will be sufficient) Maximum of £5 cash allowed for travelling spends. Unfortunatley there will not be enough room to take camp stools
